



# Can you play this game—in Hebrew? Of course you can!

## Hide and Seek (מחבואים)

### Rules

This game that is enjoyed around the world is easily played in Hebrew. A minimum of two players are needed. One player, **the stander (העומד)** stands against a tree, wall or any tall object. With eyes closed, the stander counts loudly up to 10. While the stander counts, all other players go and hide within the agreed-upon boundaries. When the counting is finished, the stander goes to search for the other players. When a player is found, the stander runs back to the counting spot, touches it, shouts "1, 2, 3!" and also shouts the name of the found player. The stander then goes to find the remaining players...
