



# Can you play this game—in Hebrew? Of course you can!

## Peekaboo (קוקו)

### Rules

Peekaboo is often the first game we introduce to baby. I challenge you to find any place where Peekaboo is not played!

Facing the infant, a parent covers their face with their hands, pauses and then reveals their face, crying “peekaboo!” as they watch their baby’s delighted face light up. Here is how to play it in Hebrew:

### Language Used

Peekaboo!	<i>ku.ku !</i>	קוקו!
Where am I?	<i>ei.fo a.ni ?</i>	איפה אני?
Where’s Jessie?	<i>ei.fo je.si ?</i>	איפה ג'סי?
Where’s mom?	<i>ei.fo i.ma ?</i>	איפה אמא?
Where’s dad?	<i>ei.fo a.ba ?</i>	איפה אבא?
Here!	<i>hi.ne !</i>	הנה!
Here I am!	<i>hi.ne a.ni !</i>	הנה אני!
Here’s Jessie!	<i>hi.ne je.si !</i>	הנה ג'סי!
I am here!	<i>a.ni po !</i>	אני פה!
I am here!	<i>a.ni kan !</i>	אני כאן!
Here’s mom!	<i>hi.ne i.ma!</i>	הנה אמא!
Mom’s here!	<i>i.ma po !</i>	אמא פה!
Mom’s here!	<i>i.ma kan !</i>	אמא כאן!
Here’s dad!	<i>hi.ne a.ba !</i>	הנה אבא!
Dad’s here!	<i>a.ba po !</i>	אבא פה!
Dad’s here!	<i>a.ba kan !</i>	אבא כאן!
