

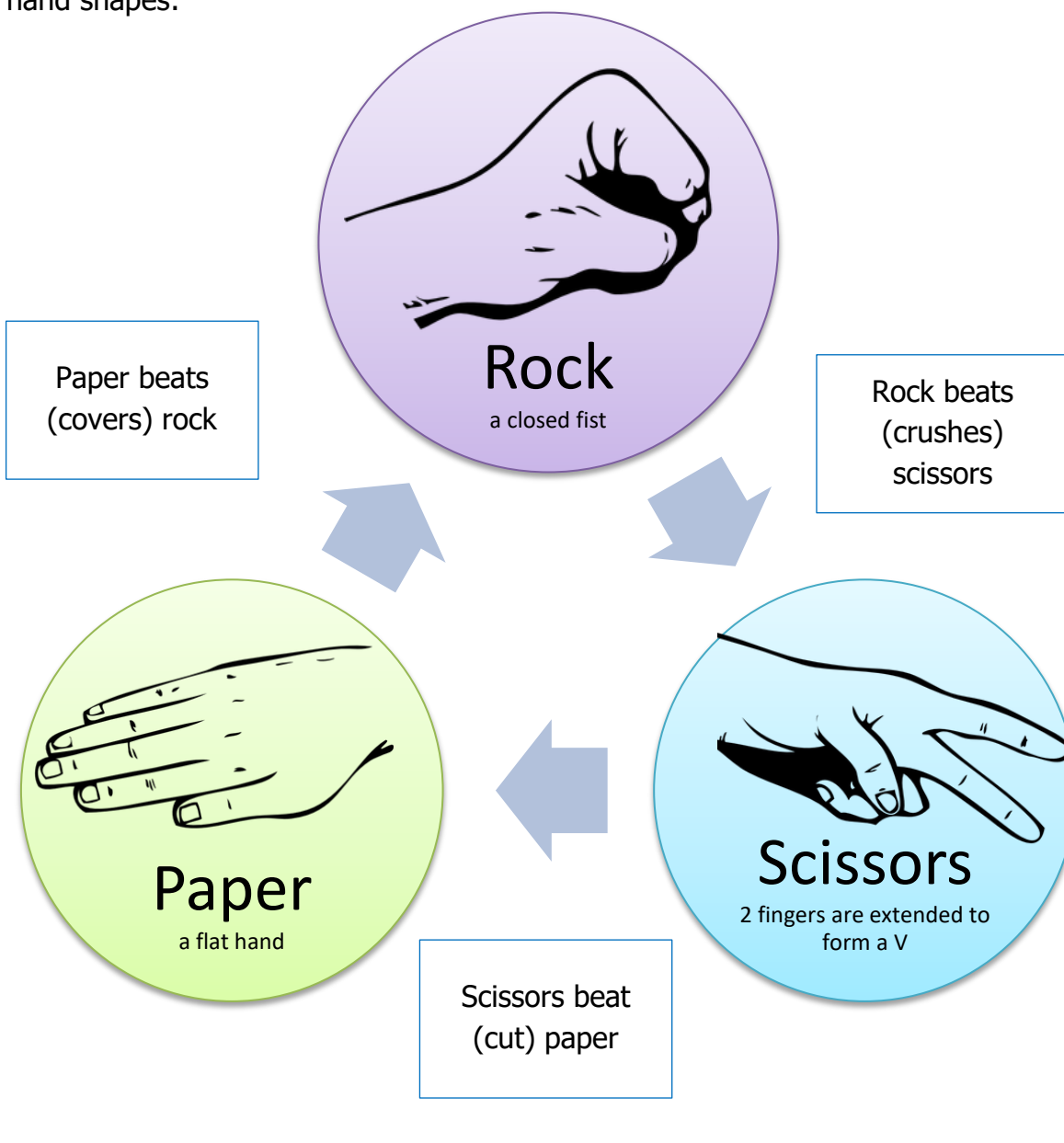


Can you play this game—in Hebrew? Of course you can!

Rules

In this game for two people, each player decides and chooses from 3 possible hand shapes:





Can you play this game—in Hebrew? Of course you can!

When both players are ready, they chant together (in Hebrew!) and then reveal their hands. The winner is determined per the rules shown in the diagram above. If both players chose the same shape, no winner is declared, and the game is repeated.
